### **DVD Packaging specifications:**

Use your creativity to create a **professional** and **attractive** DVD disc jacket containing **ALL** the finalized work you have created this quarter. Make sure the following information is visible on the DVD disc jacket, as well as your DVD disc itself:

For the contents of the DVD itself, create a DATA DVD with the following folder structure:

**Bouncing Ball**  
**Character Model Sheets**

Place your FINAL versions of each animation into the appropriate folder. Make sure to include scans of your revised character model sheets (3 pages) and place them in the **Character Model Sheets** folder.

Final animation files can be in AVI or MOV format. Make sure that they will play on a Mac and PC **BEFORE** you turn it in.

Save the final animation files on your DVD using the following names:

**bouncing\_ball.mov** (or bouncing\_ball.avi)  
**emotional\_walk.mov** (or .avi)  
**flour\_sack.mov** (or .avi)  
**teeter\_totter.mov** (or .avi)

Name your scanned character model sheets as follows:  
**turnarounds.jpg**  
**action\_poses.jpg**  
**construction.jpg**
